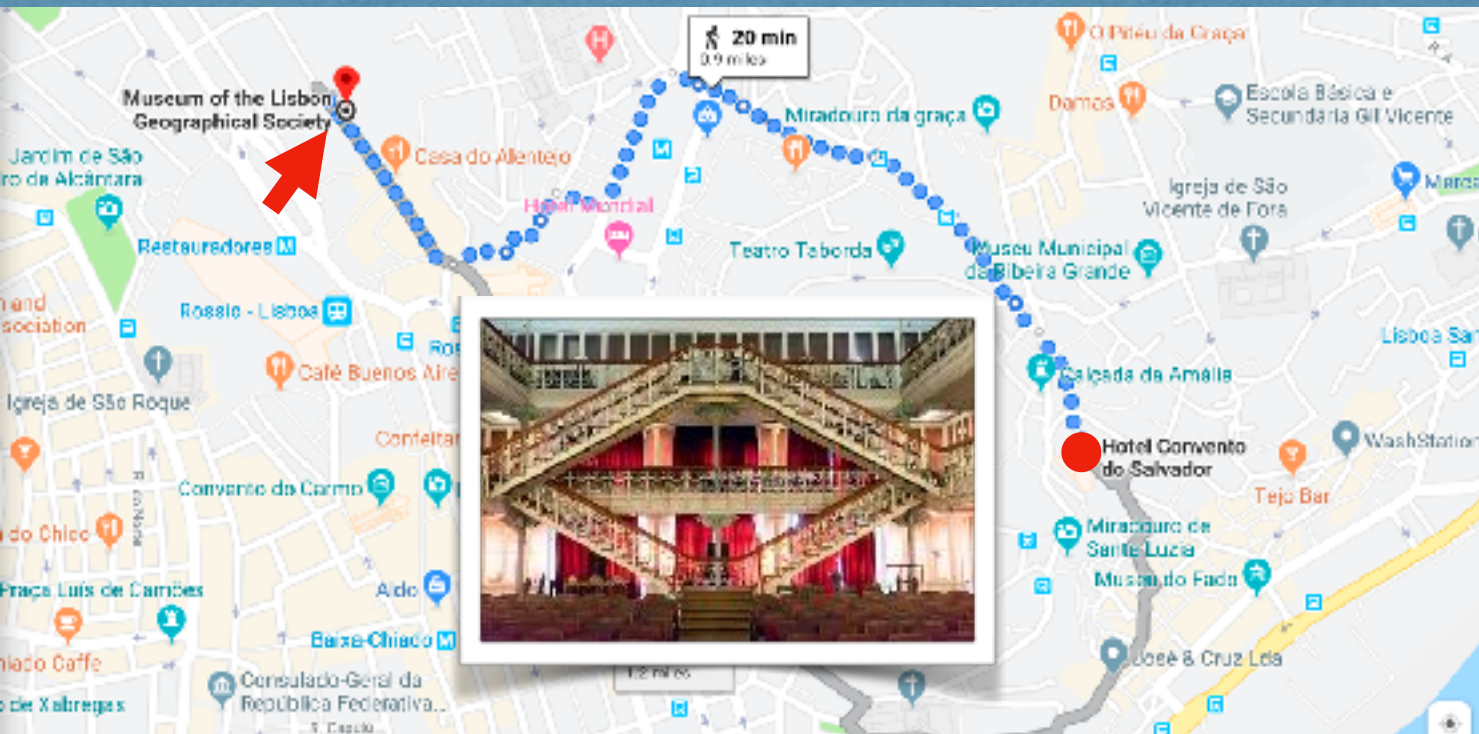


Saturday, October 5

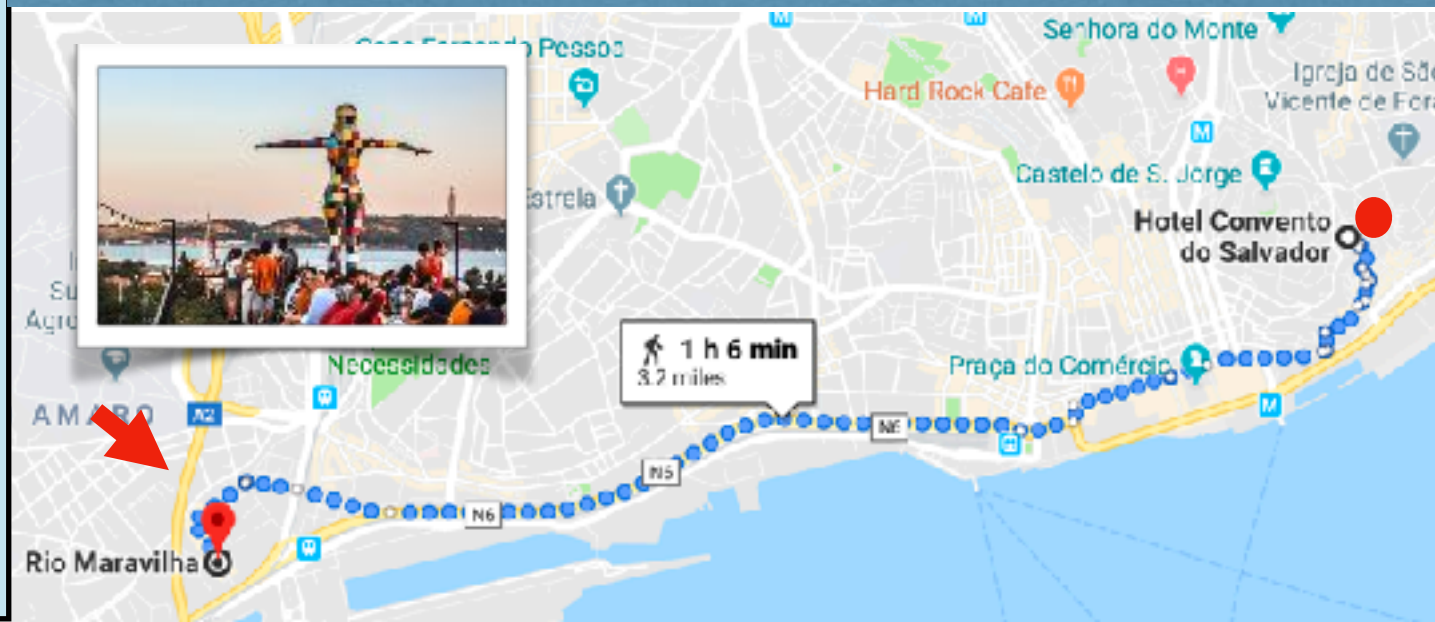


Tuesday, October 8

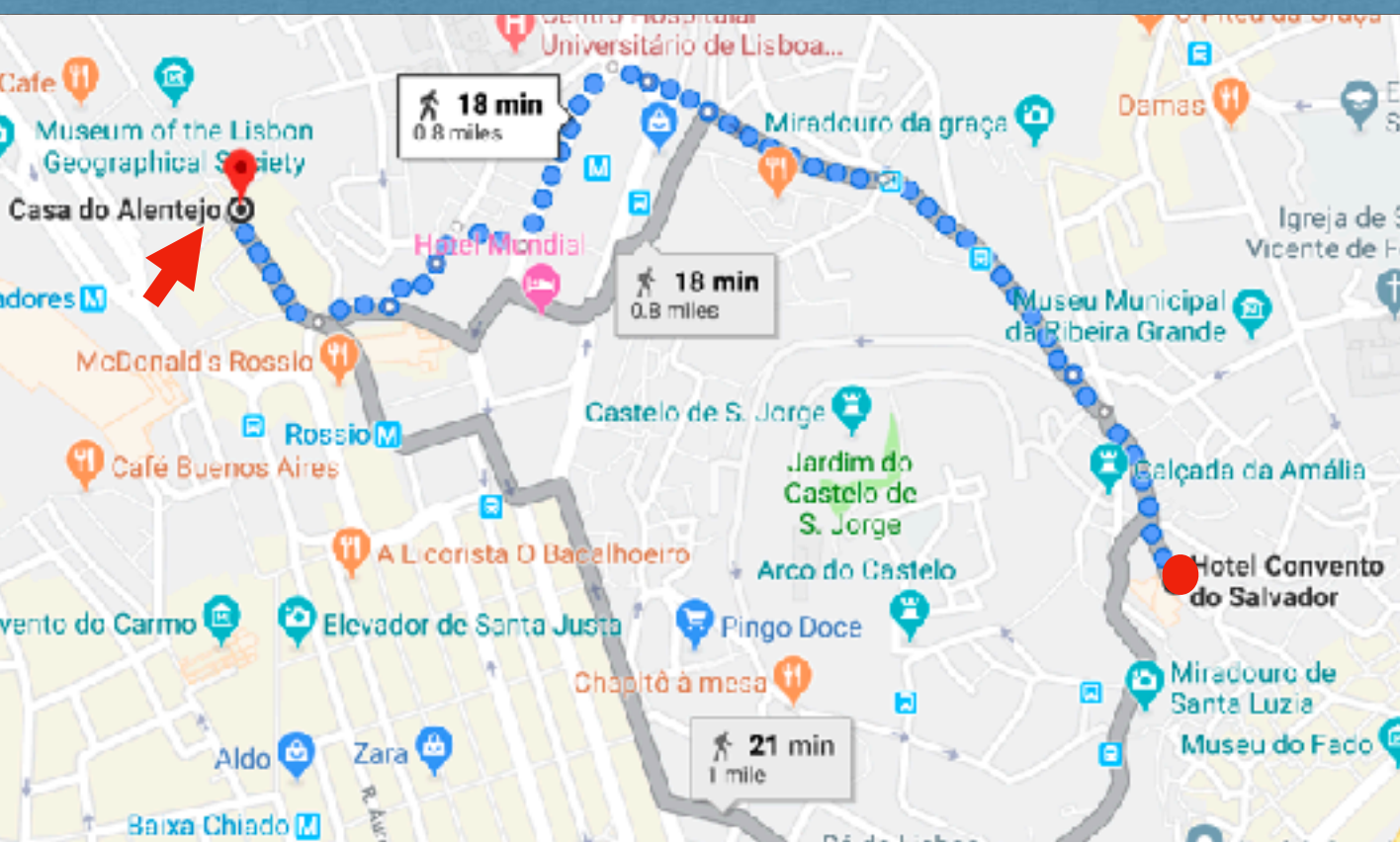


Wednesday, October 9

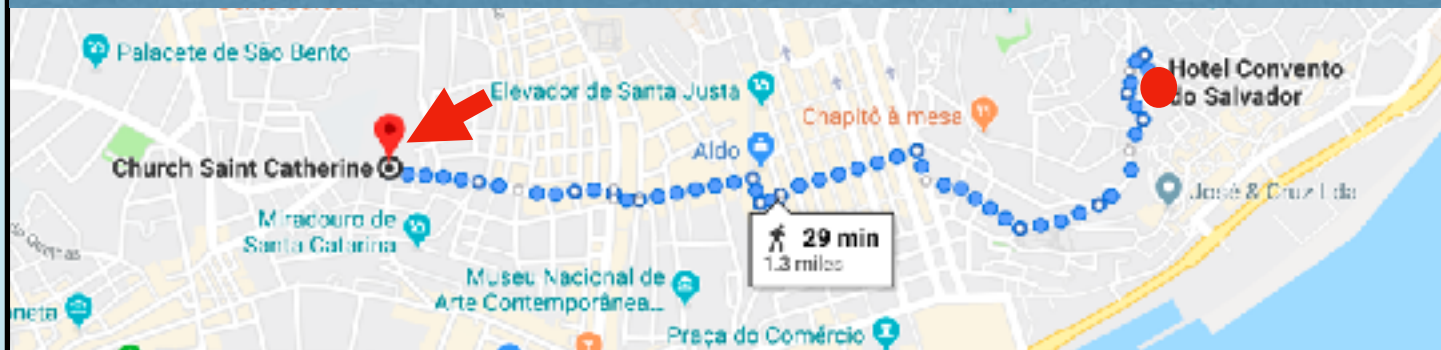

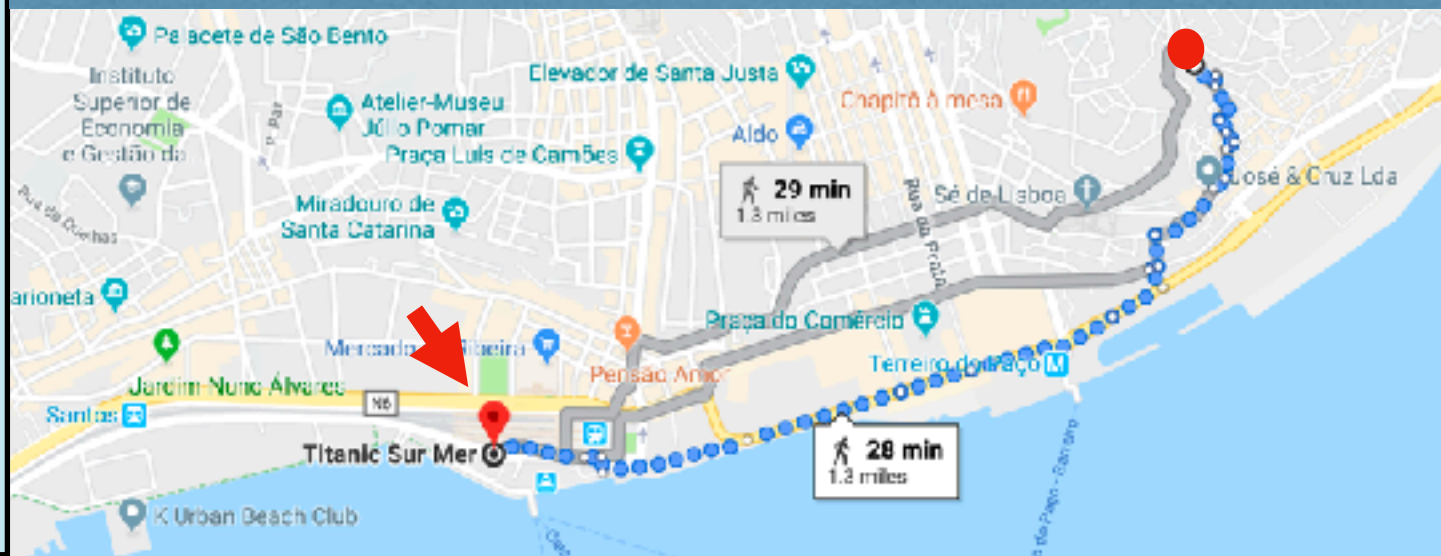

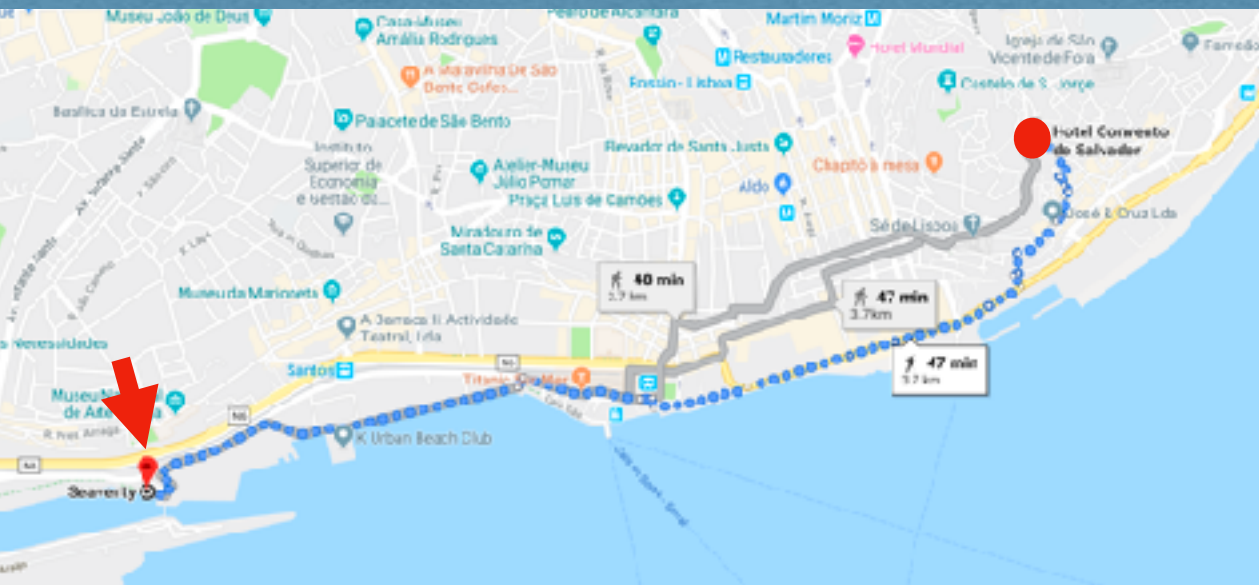
